TP4-500 - Golden Ball Turnips

55 days. Brassica rapa. Open Pollinated. The plant produces good yields of 3 to 4" turnips. The skin is yellow and the flesh is yellow. Very flavorful, sweet, tender, and mild. Nice type for mashing! Both tops and roots are good and tasty. Keeps well, will store until spring. Excellent choice for home gardens. An heirloom dating back to 1859. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 6109.



TP1-500 - Purple Top White Globe Turnip Seeds

57 days. Brassica rapa. Open Pollinated. Purple Top White Globe Turnip. The plant produces good yields of 4 to 6" diameter turnips. They are deliciously sweet and tender. Roots are white on the bottom and bright purple on top. Best when harvested when roots are 4 to 6". Leaves can be used as greens. Stores well. Excellent choice for home gardens. An heirloom variety dating back to pre-1880. United States Department of Agriculture, NSL 6119.
