## TM929-10 - OSU Blue Tomato Seeds

85 days. Solanum lycopersicum. Open Pollinated. OSU Blue Tomato. The plant produces high yields of 3 to 4" blue tomatoes. This was the first blue pigment tomato. It is blue on the outside and pinkish red flesh and has the same antioxidant that is found in blueberries. They are very sweet and are perfect for salads, sandwiches, snacks, gourmet dishes, and vegetable platters. An excellent choice for home



gardens. A variety was developed at Oregon State University by cross pollinating a regular red tomato with a blue wild tomato. Indeterminate.
