100 days. Cucurbita pepo. Open Pollinated. Bush Delicata Squash. This compact plant produces excellent yields of 4" wide by 8" long green striped oblong squash. It has rich deep golden orange flesh. The taste is similar to that of a sweet potato. This variety has a smaller seed cavity and thicker walls than other Delicata varieties. The squash has a long shelf life, up to 4 months, meaning you can enjoy eating the squash into the winter months. This bush plant spreads only 36" and is suitable for small gardens. Space them closer together for higher yields. An excellent choice for home gardens, farmer's markets, and market growers. Also known as Cornell's Bush Delicata Squash and Sweet Potato Squash. A variety was developed by Molly Jahn and George Moriarty at Cornell University. A winter squash variety. Disease Resistant: PM.

105 days. Cucurbita pepo. Open Pollinated. Honey Boat Squash. The plant produces excellent yields of high quality 8" long by 3" wide delicata squash. This squash has tan skin with green stripes. One of the sweetest squash varieties in existence. The flavor is rich and reminiscent of sweet potatoes. Stores well for months. Developed by Dr. James Baggett, Oregon State University. This bush plant is suitable for small gardens. A winter squash variety.
